Midtown International School Announces Closure Effective April 3

Atlanta, GA —March 31, 2026 — Midtown International School (MIS) announces that it will permanently close its doors on Friday, April 3, following a vote by the Board of Directors.

This decision was made after careful review of reenrollment trends and the broader economic environment. In recent years, the school has experienced declining reenrollment alongside a significant increase in demand for scholarships and financial aid. These factors have placed considerable financial strain on the institution. As a small private school, Midtown International School has been particularly impacted by these challenges, making continued operations unsustainable.

In a letter to the community, the Board of Directors said, "...the attrition of more than 20 full-pay students across grades K–7 created a financial gap that the school was not positioned to absorb. After a thorough review of all available options, the Board determined that continuing operations was no longer sustainable."

Faculty and staff, including members of the administration, were notified on Monday afternoon after the Board finalized its decision to close the school.

Midtown International School has served the Atlanta community with a mission centered on global perspective, student curiosity, and an engaging, student-focused learning environment. The school's impact is reflected in the strength of its community and the experiences of its students and families.

The school is working to support families, students, faculty, and staff during this transition. Guidance and resources will be provided to assist students with school placement and to support employees as they navigate next steps.

Midtown International School expresses its deep gratitude to its educators, staff, families, and alumni for their commitment and contributions over the years. The school's legacy will continue through the individuals and community it has shaped.
